Representative/Educator administration platform

1. Navigating the platform as a representative/educator

When you first enter the platform, it will default the view by "Classes" that provides overview of high-level metrics on current classes and course progress.

The number of modules completed by all the classes that are active

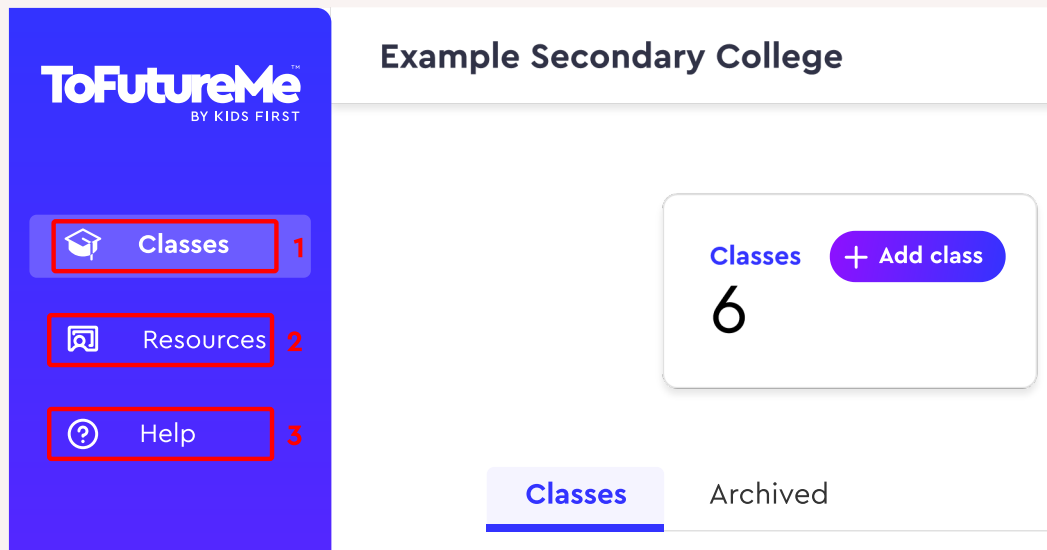
4. Class View

During course:


These resources will be your guide for the journey of the course.

5. Student view cont.

Student dashboard view includes:

1. Need urgent help

'Need urgent help' directs students with links to relevant support services should they require to do so when engaging with sensitive content material.

2. Avatar

Avatar displayed is what the student has selected during onboarding throughout the course that best represents themselves for a personalised learning experience.

3. Progress

Shows the student's progress of the module.

'Need urgent help' button

Mental health and wellbeing support is available for students throughout the course and it is accessible on the top right of the screen under 'Need urgent help'.
